

Worship Team Vision, Qualifications & Expectations

Vision:

As laid out more extensively in our philosophy of music statement, a carefully chosen musical repertoire for the church is important. We believe that our music is to be God-honoring, doctrinally sound, and musically “singable” for congregational worship. It is important to us that the congregation knows and feels comfortable singing the music that is chosen each week. We don’t believe that as a music ministry, we are here to provide entertainment for the congregation each week. This is our act of service to Jesus and to our brothers and sisters in Christ as we all worship God together.

Qualifications:

Be a “true worshiper” (John 4:23-24). Display spiritual and social maturity.

Be a faithful member or regular attender of PCS.

Possess ability to skillfully play their instrument, sing vocals, and/or skillfully operate the sound board and equipment.

Submit to the spiritual authority of the Elders through the leadership of the Music Ministry leader.

Expectations:

Music team members are expected to attend rehearsal on Thursday evening and Sunday morning of the week they are singing, playing or running the sound board.

Team members are expected to arrive on time and prepared for weekly rehearsals.

Team members are expected to commit time to individual practice to prepare for worship rehearsals and worship services.

If a team member is unable to make it for a practice or worship service, they must give the worship team leader sufficient notice, if at all possible.

We expect a personal relationship with Jesus Christ that is consistent and growing through prayers, Bible study, and fellowship with other believers.
